- I. How did Luke write his account of Christ?
 - a. It was well researched. (Luke 1:1-2)
 - i. Can you suspend disbelief?
 - ii. Luke wants you to know everything is true.
 - b. It was orderly. (Luke 1:3)
- II. Why did Luke write this book?
 - a. It was written to reassure (Luke 1:4)
 - i. Is Theophilus wrestling?

 - iii. Faith anchored in Jesus.
 - b. It was written to inspire.
 - i. Relaying the gospel to the world today...
 - c. What better place to begin this than with the incarnations of Jesus. (Luke 1:26-38; 2:1-12)
- III. What can we learn about living incarnationally from the incarnation of Jesus?
 - a. The incarnation requires going. (John 1:4; 17:18)
 - i. We must take Jesus into their world!
 - ii. God has always been a sending God.
 - iii. We engage with people so that they might have an encounter with God.
 - b. Incarnation is motivated by love. (1 John 4:9; 4:20)
 - i. What prompted God to send his son to a broken messed up world?
 - ii. There are lots of people that are hard to love.
 - iii. The art on your refrigerator door, it bears the imprint of your son.
 - iv. Everybody carries the imprint of God.
 - v. We must also recognize the impact of sin.
 - vi. The world is full of a disease & we have the only cure.
 - vii. We must hate the sin and love the sinner.
