 - ii. Grace is not making up the difference, its God paying the entire debt that we did not have any funds for.

Small Group Bible Study

Text: Romans 6:1-13

1. What motivates you to live a good life? What do you consider to be a good life?
2. In this passage “death” and “died” are used many times. What point is Paul trying to make?
3. How is the image of baptism a symbol of what Christ did?
4. In what ways do people become “slaves to sin”? How can a person escape this bondage?
5. What do you do with the flashbacks and voices in the night that keep reminding you of your past mistakes? How do we forgive ourselves and let go of the guilt?
6. What does it mean to be “dead to sin”? If we are “dead to sin” how is it that we still fall into sin so often? What does it mean to practice the teaching in verses 11-13?
7. Do we daily go out of our way to show our faith in and to God? After we have gone public with our faith, can the public see that we belong to Him through our actions.
