2. What was your life like before you were saved? How does that affect your life today?
3. In what sense is “spiritually dead” an accurate description of life without faith in Christ?
4. Salvation is described here as a gift, a kindness from God. In what way is our salvation life a gift? What do we do with this gift?
5. Why do we sometimes perceive our salvation to be related to our own efforts?
6. Describe an act of mercy you have seen recently. How can we practice the act of mercy?
7. Think of a time when you had the opportunity to show mercy but did not. Why didn’t you?
