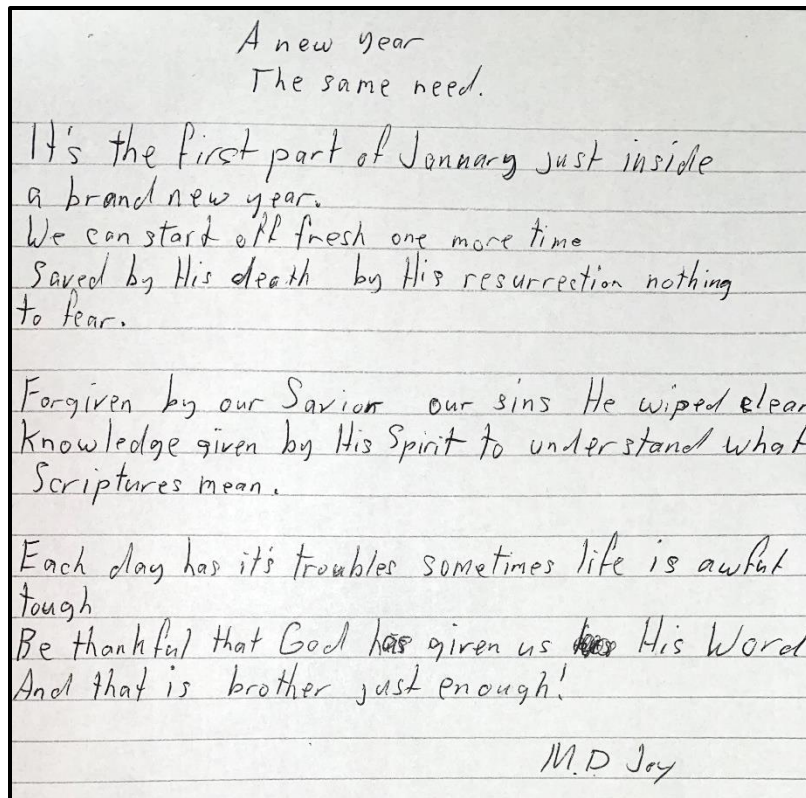
- **Charlie Daniels** is hospitalized with pneumonia. He remains in Albuquerque.
