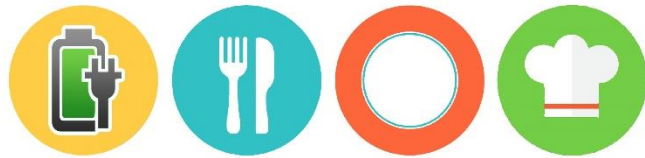

Text: Acts 2:42-47

1. What did the 3000 converts end up doing? How is God with them? Are we as committed as they were?
2. Does Country Club Road look like the church in Acts 2? Why or why not? Are there changes we need to make or ideas to brainstorm to get us looking more like the early church?
3. How much does this passage speak of worship? Which words or phrases refer to fellowship? Which ones refer to worship?
4. Focus on John 4:24. What does spirit, and truth mean? Can you have one without the other?
5. Read and discuss Hebrews 10:23-25. How do we spur one another on? What does "forsaking the assembly" mean? In what ways can you encourage others through your worship? What can we do for those who are "forsaking the assembly"?
6. Do we celebrate the mighty acts of God enough? Is there a place for telling how God has worked in our lives? How could hearing these stories help our spiritual family? The lost world around us?
7. How have you been encouraged by the worship at CCR? When have you been moved? Strengthened? Empowered? Brought to repentance?
