God: In Charge

Would we rather have God in a Jack-in-the-box? God pops up and solves the problem.

- I. God wants you to hear, "At no time am I ever off my throne."
 - a. Physical sovereigns never stay in charge – eventually they lose their throne.
 - b. In Gen. 3, the serpent doesn't talk back.
 - c. If God is in charge, what do we do with all the evil in the world?
 - i. Are there things going on in the world that God can't stop?
 - ii. Prov. 21:30.
- II. So, what does this mean?
 - a. We do not need to wonder about who's in control.
 - i. Acts 12 – James is killed, Peter is set free – yet God still reigns!
 - ii. Is. 46:10 (God speaking).
 - iii. God does not need our permission to rule as he pleases.
 - iv. Conversation at the end of Job – "Where were you. . ."
 - v. Man often thinks he is in charge.
 - vi. People who were in the right place at the right time, yet many thought they were insignificant.
 - b. Sometimes God accomplishes his will by trials and suffering.
 - i. Ps. 115:3.
 - ii. Ps. 135:6.
 - iii. If we could totally "figure out God" he would be too puny for our worship!
 - iv. Rom. 11:33-36.
 - v. When it comes to God's sovereignty, we do not need more understanding, we need more faith.
 - vi. Job's response to the difficulties that he was facing, "Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked I will depart. The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away; may the name of the Lord be praised."
 - 1. Job learned that knowing who was more important than knowing why.
 - 2. Ps. 11:3-4.

Conclusion
If God is indeed in charge, nothing should be able to frustrate our hope in him.

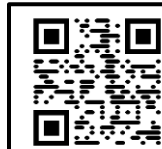
