  - a. Looking back with \_\_\_\_\_.
    - i. Mark 14:22.
    - ii. The Lord’s Supper is the great act of thanksgiving of the church.
  - b. Looking back with \_\_\_\_\_.
    - i. 1 Cor. 11:24-26.
    - ii. “Remember.”
    - iii. The Jews “remembered”.
    - iv. We “re-experience” what Christ has done for us on the cross.
  - c. Looking back at His \_\_\_\_\_.
    - i. Heb. 10:10.
    - ii. The Lord’s Supper reminds us that we live by the cross.
  - d. Looking back at our \_\_\_\_\_ with the Savior.
    - i. The sacrifice of Jesus on the cross brought forgiveness of sins and a new covenant.
    - ii. Matt. 26:28.
- II. But it is also about looking forward with the thought of victory.
  - a. There was an empty tomb!
    - i. Thomas’ response in John 20:28, “My Lord and my God!”
    - ii. Should it be solemn, yes; but it must also be joyous. How do the two go together?
  - b. There will be another banquet!
    - i. The Lord’s Supper points forward to the Second coming.
    - ii. 1 Cor. 11:26.
