### **Gideon: God's Transforming Presence**


God is in the business of taking weak, insignificant people and transforming them by his presence.

- The condition of Israel (6:1-10). ١.
  - a. Yet God sends a prophet, not a judge.
  - b. But God did not leave them there, he never does.
- The call of Gideon (6:11-16). 11.
  - a. The state of Gideon's family.
    - i. This shows that Gideon was both poor and afraid.
    - ii. He is a defeated, discouraged man, filled with doubts and fears.
  - b. God's transforming presence.
    - i. God has done this before: ii. Some people see flaws and failings – God
    - sees our possibilities.
  - c. Gideon's problems.
    - i. Discouragement and inadequacy.
    - ii. Notice God's response in vs. 14.
      - 1. "Go in the strength you have....I will be with you."
      - 2. 2 Cor. 3:5.
    - iii. Our weaknesses do not hinder God!
      - 1. 2 Cor. 12:9.
      - 2. What we need most is not selfconfidence, but God confidence.
- III. The confirmation of Gideon (6:17-24).
  - a. Gideon has come to realize that there is something special about this man.
  - b. Even Gideon can't miss this message.
  - c. Gideon's alter "God is Peace."
    - i. This is a major step forward in Gideon's faith.
    - ii. He is taking the relationship public.

On his own Gideon was a weak, faltering doubting man. Once he meets God, he is never the same again.
