Matt. 9:35-38.

What happens when the seed is sown?

- I. You can tell a man's priorities by what he prays about.
  - a. One of his priorities was seeking workers.
  - b. Song "I want to be a Worker for the Lord."
  - c. Do you want to be a worker for the Lord?
- II. Jesus is looking for people who:
  - a. We must be burdened about the spiritual condition of the lost.
    - i. Compassion deep in the bowels.
    - ii. Jesus felt compassion for the lost, not contempt.
    - iii. What do you tend to belly ache about?
    - iv. People need the Lord.
    - v. We need to shift our focus from their sinfulness to their helplessness.
  - b. We must be open to the spiritual potential of the lost.
    - i. The Hebrew concept of compassion was "love from the womb."
    - ii. Long before the child was born you had a passion for that child.
    - iii. When Jesus sees people like this, he sees a harvest!
  - c. We must be aware of the spiritual readiness of the lost.
    - i. A harvest presupposes that seed has already been sown.
    - ii. Who planted the seed?
  - d. We must be committed to the priority of prayer for workers.
    - i. Are we poachers or reapers?
    - ii. Praying for more workers is not an option for disciples.
  - e. We must be excited when God answers your prayers by sending you.
    - i. You might be directly in the path.
    - ii. You might be the answer to somebody else's prayer.
