- I. Simon would have been appalled on a couple of different fronts.
 - a. The lack of reaction from this “up incoming” rabbi.
 - i. Luke 7:39.
 - ii. In one way Simon was right: this rabbi was not what anyone thought he would be.
 - b. Jesus chooses a great time to tell a story about who’s invited into the kingdom of God.
 - i. Luke 7:40-47.
 - ii. The invited are those that respond to Jesus as the only solution to the problem.
 - c. Why does Luke include this story?
 - i. This text reminds us that our response to Jesus must be one of expressive love.
 - ii. We all have a sin debt leading to our destruction.
 1. Eph. 2:1.
 2. Eph. 2:4-6.
- II. Our answer speaks volumes:
 - a. It shows in our willingness to humbly serve Jesus.
 - i. Simon didn’t address any of the needs of Jesus.
 - ii. The woman was quick to see that his feet hadn’t been washed.
 - b. It shows as we passionately express adoration to Jesus.
 - i. Simon had little passion for Jesus.
 - ii. Luke 7:45.
 - c. It shows when we surrender anything that doesn’t belong in our lives anymore.
