- I. We must first realize:
 - a. That God is a refuge for his people (1).
 - i. He is always available. Heb. 6:18-19 (context: the certainty of God's promises to Abraham.)
 - ii. He is completely adequate "our strength."
 - iii. He is readily accessible "very present."
 - b. That God lives among his people (5).
 - i. He is a God of purpose "Most High (4)."
 - ii. He is a God of power "Lord of Hosts (7)."
 - iii. He is a God of patience "God of Jacob (7)."
 - c. That God sends a river to his people (4).
 - i. A refreshing river "Makes glad."
 - ii. A river that brings life.
 - 1. Ez, 47:9.
 - 2. John 7:37-39.
- II. How must we respond?
 - a. Reflect on these things.
 - i. If God is a refuge, therefore . . . fear is illogical (2).
 - ii. If God is a resident, therefore.... The city is immovable (5).
 - iii. If God has a river, therefore. . . .Christianity is invincible (5b).
 - b. Review what God has done (8-9).
 - c. Rejoice in what he has promised (10).
- III. Conclusion: We must relax! "Be still (10)."
