 - i. The bad news is that they had killed the Messiah who had been sent to them.
 - ii. The good news is that God had sent his son to die as atonement for sin.
 - b. When the Holy Spirit empowers the church today it sees the spiritual signs and courageously warns of impending judgment.
- Edifies new believers. Acts 2:38-41. III.
 - a. When you became a Christian you were filled with the Holy Spirit.
 - i. God doesn't just forgive our sins; he grants the Holy Spirit to us.
 - ii. It is not always an emotional experience, but a spiritual reality.
 - b. Acts 2:42 records four ways the new believers were edified.
 - i. They devoted themselves to the apostles teaching.
 - ii. They devoted themselves to fellowship.
 - iii. They devoted themselves to the breaking of bread.
 - iv. They devoted themselves to prayer


