 - a. You ought to be able to tell where I'm from, by how I live.
 - i. Eph. 4:22-24.
 - ii. We start to look like our Father again.
 - b. What is over in your old life?
- II. So, our walk. . .
 - a. Should be radical in its morality.
 - i. There is a basic innate morality, but God's morality is radically different.
 - ii. Paul says in 3:5.
 1. How do we do this? We starve it.
 2. Rom. 13:14.
 3. Gal. 5:16.
 - b. Should be radical in its equality.
 - i. The kingdom of heaven is very exclusive, but it is also very inclusive.
 - ii. You only get in through Christ, but anybody can get in.
 - iii. Col. 3:11.
 - c. Should be radical in its charity.
 - i. Goodness is not just the opposite of badness.
 - ii. You know a Christian not only by what he doesn't do, but by what he does.
 - iii. Col. 3:12-14.
 - iv. Notice vs. 13 (on forgiveness).
 1. Let God handle the moral issue of justice.
 2. Eph. 4:32.
